PITTSBURGH, April 23, 2007 – MAX Environmental Technologies, Inc., an environmental services firm, has secured \$4.5 million in financing from a private equity source and PNC Bank for the construction of a Containment and Processing (CAP) complex at MAX’s Yukon, PA facility. The expansion, slated for completion in Fall 2007, will increase MAX’s capacity to treat, manage and process hazardous wastes, including Electric Arc Furnace (EAF) Dust generated by the steel industry. Charleroi, PA-based General Industries will be the project’s general contractor.
