With the steel industry generating more than 1 million tons of EAF dust each year, this state-of-the-art facility will increase MAX's capacity to treat, manage and process up to 200,000 tons of Electric Arc Furnace (EAF) Dust per year as well as other metal-bearing dusts. The facility will give MAX other capabilities including chemical storage, drum management, waste storage, waste crushing and lead battery recycling. Dynamic features of the facility include both pneumatic and dump trailer deliveries, roll-off and vacuum box off loading.

MAX received final approval from the PA Department of Environmental Protection for EAF Dust treatment and disposal in August, 2006.
